Poster sessions may be on any topic related to libraries and should include items such as graphs, diagrams, pictures, photographs, data, and narrative on boards to stand on a 4 x 6-foot table.

The **submission deadline** for applications is **September 3, 2004**. The review committee will respond to submissions by September 8.

General Information and Guidelines

Presenters must provide their own display materials and are encouraged to have ample handout materials available. All handouts should be prepared prior to the conference.

There will be three times scheduled for the poster sessions in the exhibit hall. The conference will provide a table and two chairs for each accepted presentation. Two 4 x 6-foot tables will be available for each session. Presenters will set up their displays before their scheduled session and take them down promptly after the session. Please note that prior planning is key – the easier it is for you to set up and take down your materials, the better.

During their assigned time periods, participants informally discuss their presentations with conference attendees. Poster session presenters must be present for the entire time of the poster session.

Poster sessions are not provided with access to electricity or the Internet.

Poster sessions may present any of the following: report of a research study; analysis of a practical problem-solving effort; or description of an innovative library program.
