The NDLA web site was brought up on a LunarPages commercial web server in May 2007. The process went smoothly aside from a DNS (domain name server) problem experienced by users on the North Dakota State Government computer network. The www.ndla.info URL continued to link to the old site on computers set up to use the state's DNS. The IT Coordinator for the North Dakota State Library is working with the North Dakota State IT Department to correct the problem. Until the problem is resolved, people using those computers will need to use the www.ndlaonline.org URL to access the new site. Any of the URLs below will work for most users.
